LAND COVER CHANGE 2001-2019



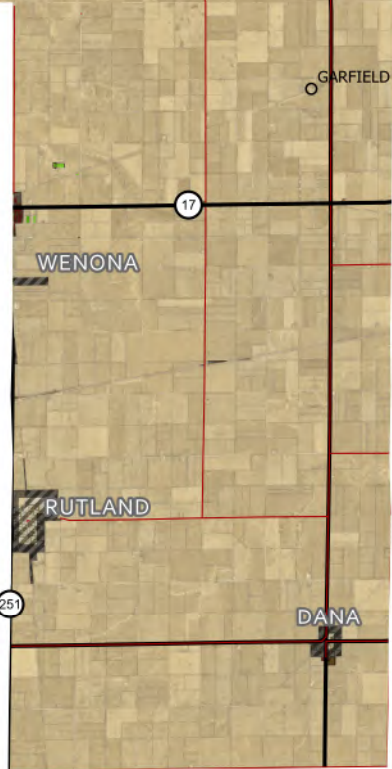
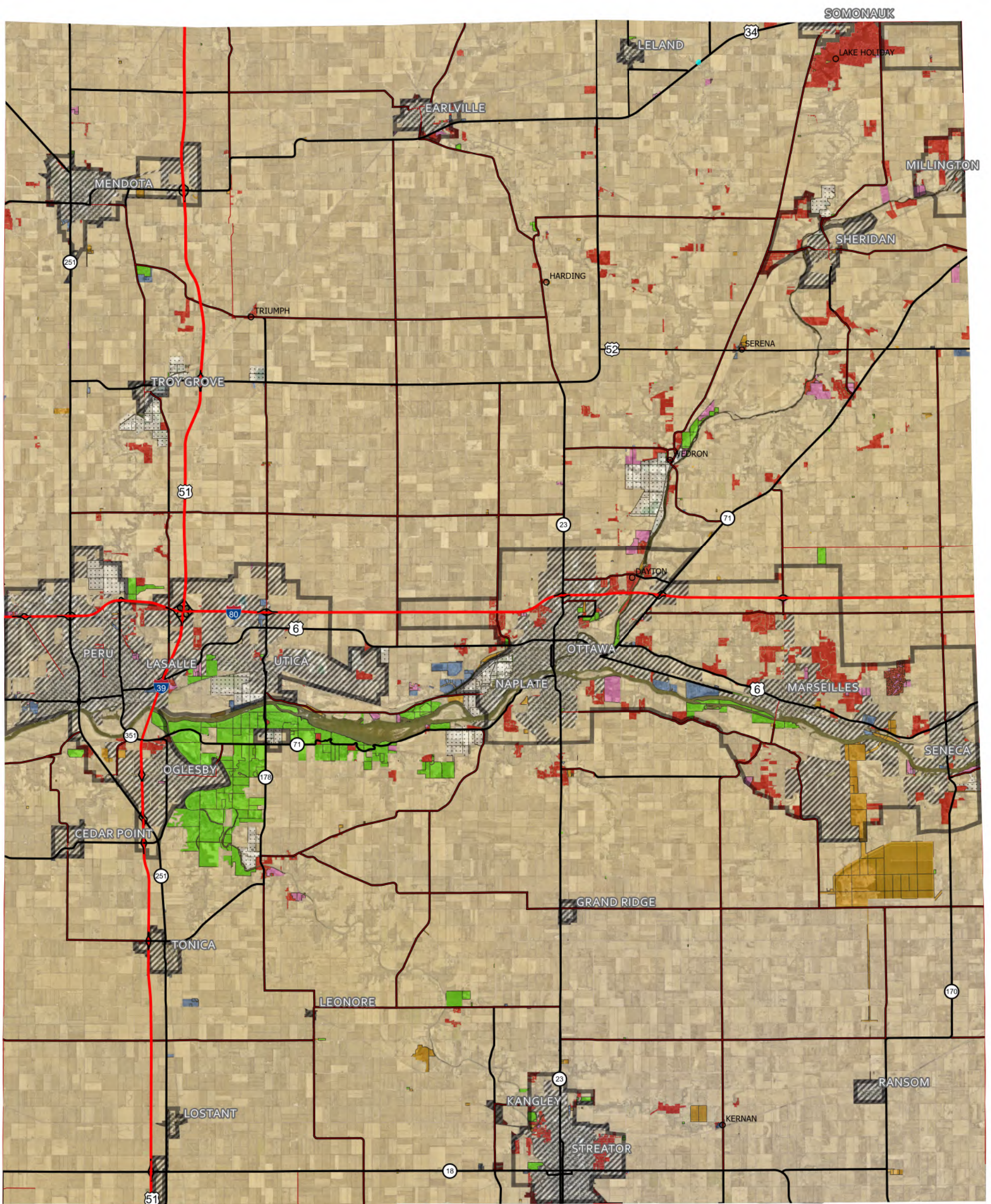

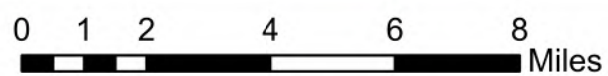


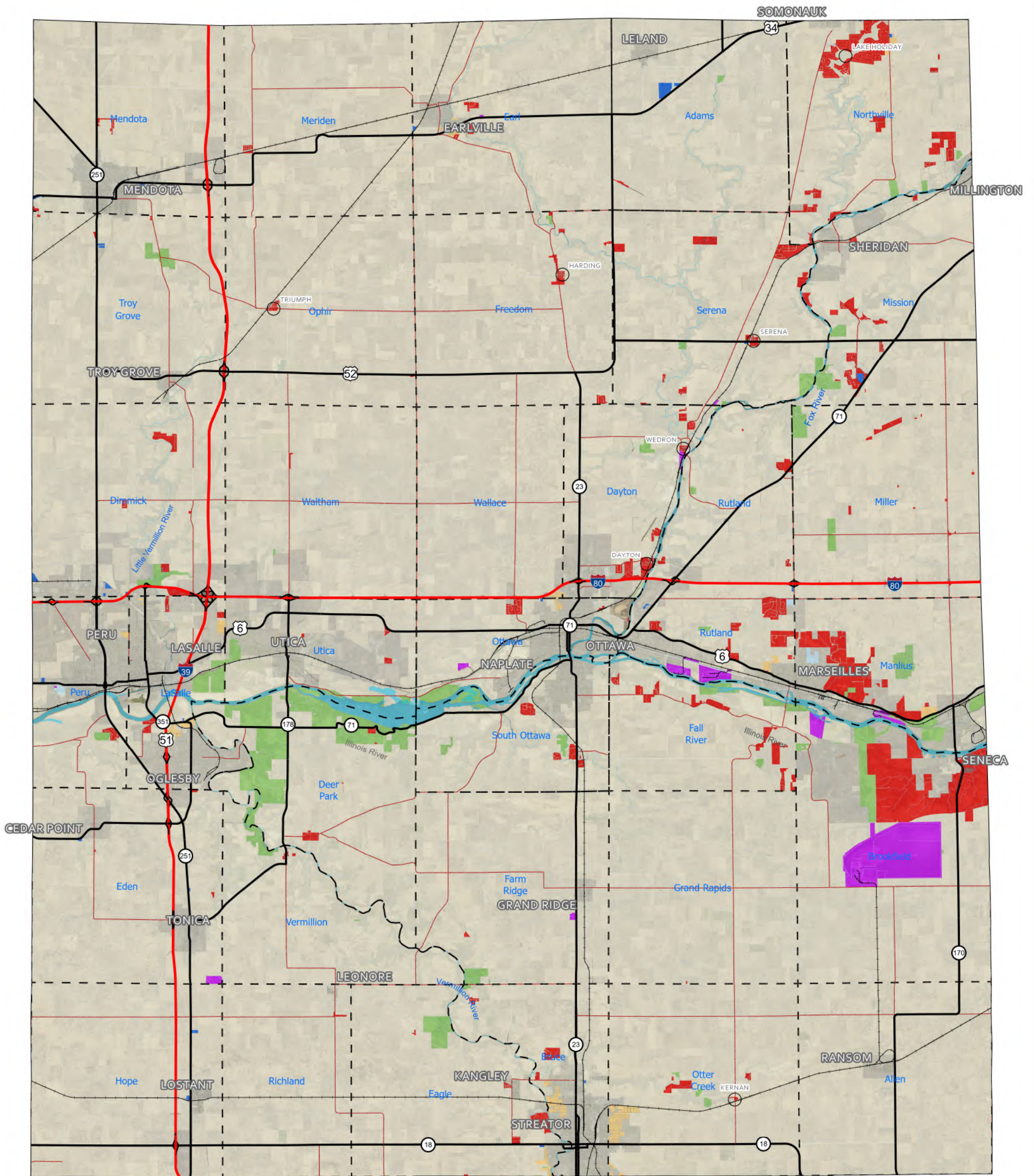


LASALLE COUNTY **EXISTING LAND USE MAP** Plan to 2030+

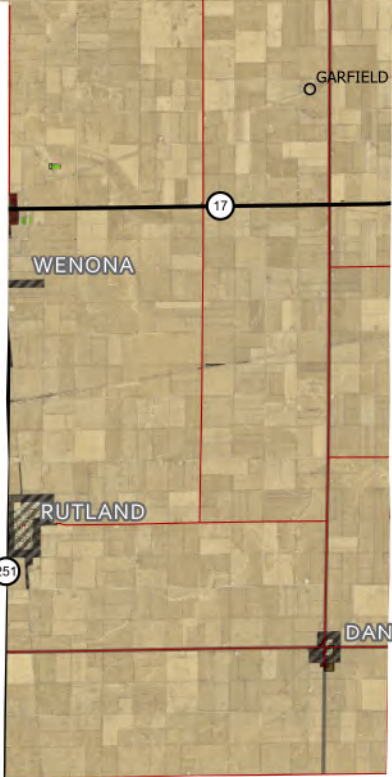
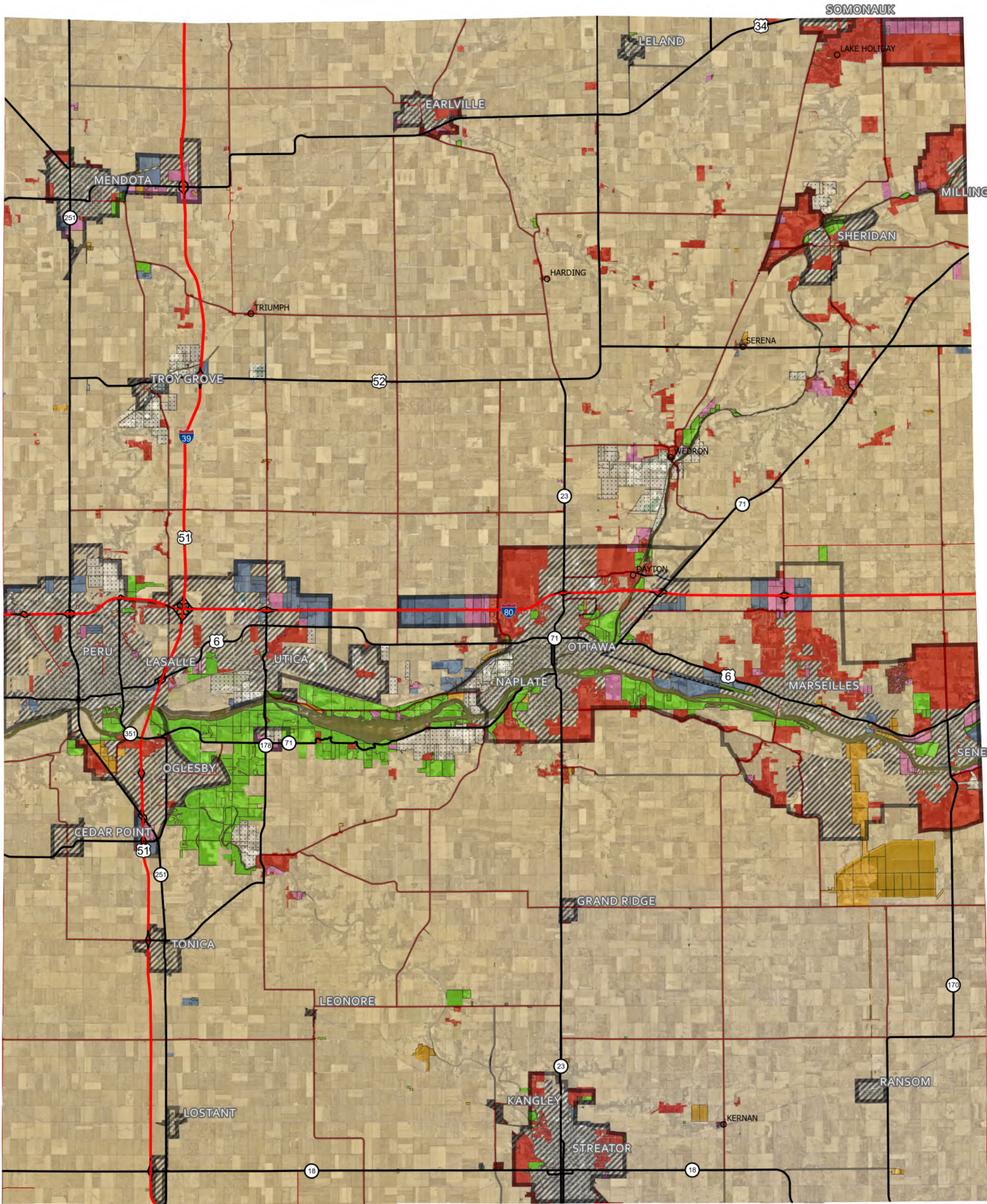
