



Who is this Woman?


"Jane Doe" is an unidentified white female found in Mission Township, (Near Norway) LaSalle County, Illinois on September 13, 1991. Forensic examination revealed the woman was approximately 5'4", 120 pounds, and was approximately 35 to 45 in age and would currently be 60 to 70 years old. When found, underneath her was a curtain with hooks still attached. "Jane" was wearing a white, men's style dress shirt with vertical stripes and black spandex pant. There were no shoes or personal effects. She had a significant amount of dental work, breast implants and two (2) tattoos. A tattoo of a cross with a red flower on it was on her upper left breast area, and a tattoo of a star shaped flower and a multicolored flower growing from a stem was on her right lower abdomen. Her system did contain cocaine. Due to the lack of dental and a DNA match, as well as the fact no one apparently reported her missing, it has been hard to identify her.
