With the General Primary coming soon, Lori L. Bongartz, LaSalle County Clerk, would like to remind residents of LaSalle County who still need to register to vote or change their address that they may do so prior to Election Day at the LaSalle County Clerk's Office, 707 E Etna Road, Ottawa, IL. Registration will also be available at Bongartz's office as well as at all 119 precincts in LaSalle County on Election Day.

Bongartz is advising persons who may need to register and want to avoid long lines on Election Day to take advantage of Grace Period Registration and Voting at the County Clerk's Office on Etna Road. Persons needing to register will need to provide 2 forms of identification-one must have the person's name and correct address and the other form to verify the person's name.

Grace Period Registration and Voting and Early Voting hours for the final days are as follows:

Saturday June 18, 2022	8:00 A.M. to 12:00 Noon
Monday June 20, 2022	8:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M.
Tuesday thru Friday June 21 – June 24, 2022	8:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.
Saturday June 25, 2022	8:00 A.M. to 12:00 Noon
Sunday June 26, 2022	10:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.

Additionally, on Tuesday, June 28th, 2022, the County Clerk's Office will be open for Grace Period Registration and Voting from 8:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.

Also properly registered voters may Vote by Mail by submitting an application ballot. Upon receipt of a signed application to Vote by Mail, the ballot will be mailed to the voter. The last day to accept an application to have a ballot mailed is Thursday, June 23rd, 2022.
