

REQUEST FOR BIDS

Bids are requested by the **LaSalle County Sheriff** for 41 Body Worn Cameras, storage and evidentiary software which includes redaction of audio and visual items. Redaction shall be automated and not required to be done manually frame by frame. The body manufacturer of the body worn cameras must also offer integrated vehicle mounted cameras, aka dash cams, to work in conjunction with the software solution and body worn cameras. Footage should be able to be viewed live and transferred directly to the storage solution when an active internet connection is available.

Description:

Forty-one (40 issued and 1 spare) body worn cameras and charging solutions integrated into a software and storage solution with maintenance and warranty for a five (5) year warranty with features including but not limited to the equivalent of the AXON3 Camera System and evidence.com software:

40 - BWC Unlimited with TAP (1 Spare Camera, total 41 BWC)

40 - AB3 Camera Bundle (1 Spare Mount and items, total 41)

2 - AB3 1-Bay Dock Bundle

1 - AB3 Multi Bay Dock Bundle (Spare)

Contract Type: One time

Submission of Bids: Bids will be accepted until August 31, 2022 2:00PM at the **LaSalle County Board Office (Room 245), LaSalle County Governmental Center, 707 E. Etna Road, Ottawa, IL 61350**. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Public Safety Committee meeting at 9:00 AM September 1, 2022, LaSalle County Governmental Center, 707 E. Etna Road, Ottawa, IL 61350.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish and pay for a criminal background investigation for all employees involved in the project.

The successful bidder will be required to comply with all provisions of the acts of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois related to Wage Rates, Discrimination, Sexual Harassment, Alcohol Use, Preference to Illinois Workmen, Fair Employment Practices Commission, and Equal Employment Opportunity.

No Illinois O.E. Sales Tax will be required for this work.

Per latest prevailing wage ordinance adopted by LaSalle County, the successful bidder shall not pay less than the prevailing rates of wages as determined by the Illinois Department of Labor to all laborers, workmen and mechanics performing work under this contract, and shall comply with the requirements of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act (820 ILCS 130/1-12). All contractors' bonds shall include a provision as will guarantee the faithful performance of such prevailing wage clause as provided by this bid specification or contract.

A successful bidder shall provide certificate of insurance establishing compliance with LaSalle County Resolution No. 10-141 "**A RESOLUTION UPDATING MINIMUM INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS**" dated August 12, 2021.

The successful bidder will be required to submit evidence of compliance with the "responsible bidder" criteria as defined in LaSalle County Board Resolution No. 00-184 "**A RESOLUTION DEFINING RESPONSIBLE BIDDER**", dated December 8, 1997, and Resolution No. 10-32 "**AMENDING RESOLUTION DEFINING RESPONSIBLE BIDDER**" dated February 11, 2010.

The successful bidder shall be required to comply with the Substance Abuse Prevention on Public Works Act (Public Act 95-0635).

LaSalle County reserves the right to reject any and all Bids, to waive any irregularities in the Bidding, and to award contract in LaSalle County's best interests.
